Summer Missions Education Program

Orphanage Outreach Overview:

Orphanage Outreach is a non-profit organization headquartered in Glendale, Arizona. In 1994, we “adopted” the Hope of a Child Orphanage in Monte Cristi, the Dominican Republic. Because we have been blessed with volunteers and resources, we have expanded our scope to adopt the whole community. Our strategy is to partner American church teams with the local Dominican churches.

Summer Program:

During the summer of 2009, from May 30th through August 22nd, we are involving Christian individuals, families, and church teams to provide a combination Vacation Bible School/Sports Camp/Learning Camp to thousands of children in the Dominican Republic. Each week will involve at least one new location, depending on the number of volunteers who join us. The camp will open with worship, and then the children will be separated into different groups to rotate through a bible, arts and crafts, English, health, and sports and recreation station. We will be teaching English and literacy, with a Christian focus. Often, Dominican adults will attend the camp with their kids, providing adult ministry opportunities. Of course, each week will also include time at the nearby beach!

Short Term Mission Program:

You are invited to join us this summer, as an individual, with a friend or your family, or as part of a group for a short term mission of one week or longer. This is a great opportunity to share Christ’s love, to learn about a different culture, and to practice your Spanish!

Summer Long Term Volunteers/Internship Program:

As a long term volunteer or college intern joining us for two months or longer, you will be helping to design and lead the camps. You will lead the various camp stations, lead the children’s groups, and assist the short term volunteers. This is a great opportunity for education majors, Spanish majors, art majors, music majors, youth ministry majors, and anyone who enjoys working with children.

Housing/Food/Transportation/Logistics Support:

You will be living in Orphanage Outreach run facilities in “summer camp” style accommodations. Good running water toilets and showers are provided, as are excellent Dominican meals prepared by Orphanage Outreach trained cooks. Ground transportation is provided between the airport and your location.

Why Orphanage Outreach?

Experienced: Over 7000 volunteers have joined Orphanage Outreach in the Dominican Republic since 1994.

Professional: Full time American and Canadian staff live at the orphanage and will lead your program.

Safe: Your safety and health is our number one priority. The Dominican Republic is very friendly and safe. We have never had an issue of a volunteer’s personal safety being threatened. Common sense safety guidelines are in place to keep you safe. All bottled water is used in cooking; showers are chlorinated. Top rated travelers medical insurance is included. Good clinics are located nearby.

Support:

We ask that you raise your own support for the trip. The program fee for one week is \$800, for one month is \$1800, for two months is \$2800, and for three months is \$3500. The program fee includes your housing, food, ground transportation, insurance, and support for the orphanage. Group and family scholarships are available. With your registration, you will receive an on-line personal fund-raising page to help raise support. All donations to Orphanage Outreach are tax deductible.
